

IAAS World Congress is our most important event that gathers all IAAS members across the globe. The 63rd IAAS World Congress took place online under the theme **“Evolving in times of crisis: Stepping up our IAAS Community”**. It took place from July 18th to July 31st 2020. We have had over 20 hours of General Assembly, workshops, soft skill trainings, an online trade fair which was held in a 24-hours period, we were able to know the cultures of most of our member countries, we elected a new board, welcomed new countries, voted on over 60 amendments to our constitution and by-laws, voted for the hosts of the next big events, and most importantly we were able to step up and progress despite the global pandemic.


Hello!
