It is almost the end of the term, I don't believe we came all this way!

These two months as always, I continued to support and guide the work of the Executive Board but I was also busy with other things of course!

In these 2 months, I represented IAAS in 2 external events, one is from IFSA (Interim Meeting) where I presented IAAS and talked about how Covid-19 impacted us, it was a great opportunity to network and discuss with a similar organization as ours, the second one was an event called Cultivating conversations organized by OCP North America and Emerging Ag, from this event, I was linked with the Youth Alliance for Zero Hunger for which I am coordinating the process of having IAAS as a convening organization.

Internally, I represented the Executive Board in the Directors Meeting of the MENA region and the Special General Assembly for Africa to elect new Regional Boards. I created the first ever Regional Board Start-Up Package filled with a whole arsenal of resources which will support the Regional Boards with their work, of course the rest of the Executive Board helped me out with the content, hopefully it will be useful for all generations to come and will increase the efficiency of the Regional Boards' work.

Additionally, I collected input from different members and created a concept note for an IAAS Advisory Board which is going to support after its inception the IAAS officials and members throughout the years.

I represented IAAS along with Thomas (IAAS Netherlands ND) and Nina (IAAS Belgium ND) in the GCA and thanks to that, IAAS will take part in several intergenerational dialogues, more information will be shared about that.

For the Village Concept Projects, I was able to support the creation of a new one in Togo which is being jointly developed by IAAS Togo and IAAS France, and I hosted a workshop-like discussion with IAAS Switzerland to motivate them to be involved in one of the VCPs.

I also coordinated with the help of Majo, IAAS Americas Regional Director and the rest of EB/CB the creation of IAAS Argentina, such a motivated team which I welcome once more to our big family!

In the next months, I will mostly be busy with the organization of the World Congress which is going to be online from the 30th of July to the 5th of August 2021, all I can tell you for now is that we are planning to make it unforgettable for all of us, we will keep you posted about it. U have been very close in the organization with IAAS Guatemala and I can say that they are organizing a great event.

Following this, several updates to our database have been made:

- The new Regional and National Exchange Coordinators around the world.
- The offer of the exchange program, **a total of 50 worldwide**, many of these are not receiving people due to the Pandemic, but we will start an advertising campaign of the active places and that currently receive students, must be attentive to our Instagram @exproiaas.
- Exchange participants around the world, **44 in total**, 11 have had a totally successful application and are close to traveling, 1 has canceled their application and the rest is waiting for a response from the company.
- Testimonials from people who have done the exchange program before and are giving us feedback as well as from companies that are IAAS allies.

1. Hosting Place cooperation

Here you will find **4 documents**: the first is an email that is written and you can send to the companies/farms that you want to join our exchange offer (talk about what IAAS is, what is the ExPro and our intention to make a formal agreement with them), additionally you will find a brochure that you can attach it to the mail you send, in expro partnership proposal is an editable document that you can use when you introduce with companies and last and not more importantly the collaboration contract that must be signed when the company agrees to receive interns from abroad.

2. Application process

Here you will find all the guides to do the interviews between NExCos + Exchange participants + OP Takers as well as the acceptance and invitation letters, finally the student agreement.

3. Evaluation

In this evaluation can be done online by this link: <https://bit.ly/EvaluationExPro> where we will receive feedback from students who have made an expro as well as the op takers who have received people previously, finally the certificate that is given to the student at the end of their expro.

4. Biosecurity booklet

This document can be sent to people traveling abroad where you can follow certain measures (which may change from country to country), so that the student travels safely to their expro.

5. National booklet

In this folder I have set an example of how we can disseminate information from our countries in particular what is culture, food, cost of living, tourist places, etc. That is useful information for people traveling to unknown countries. There is an editable document that you can download and fill with your own information.

Finally we continue to work together with the VP of communications in the **ExPro Marketing Project**, very soon you will have more information. Without more to say, I say good-bye.

Hello Everybody

The last months have been busy. First of all, there was the publication of the Finance Standard: the document that explains how to get your financial situation on order. By following the guidelines of the Finance Standard, you will be able to make your committee thriving like a real business with amazing potential, and financial sustainability and independence. There will be a small update on the Finance Standard and the previously published Merchandise Guidelines soon, which will mainly provide a fancy layout for both documents. The most of the work is already done, but I have other priorities currently.

One of these priorities is the upcoming Finance Summit, organised in collaboration with my Quality Board, the ITC and the VPER. This is an event that will contain a series of workshops, trainings and webinars all related to finance and business, to enable you to professionally manage your committee. The skills you will learn, will also be very useful in your future professional life if you will have anything to do with company-life.

Something else that we have been working on is the Global Project Contest. In total, 10 committees have submitted a full Project Proposal to IAAS World to compete for the first three places to win the prize money. If they win the money, they can use it to pay their costs and invest it in their projects to create even more great impact. Normally, you will hear about these projects soon on social media.

Talking about money grants, we as IAAS World are also looking for some money: there are new open application rounds for the Erasmus+ programme, so we are currently looking into that. It is all very technical, but hopefully we manage to find a good grant and prepare a good application the next month so that the European union can help us with very welcome money.

Last but not least, the RFCos and me are still guiding countries in setting their strategies right to find enough money to pay their annual Membership Fees. There are still a lot of countries that have to pay with the deadline almost passed. If you need help or a reduction, you can still ask for it. We have already been able to help more than five countries in totally transforming their financial situation.

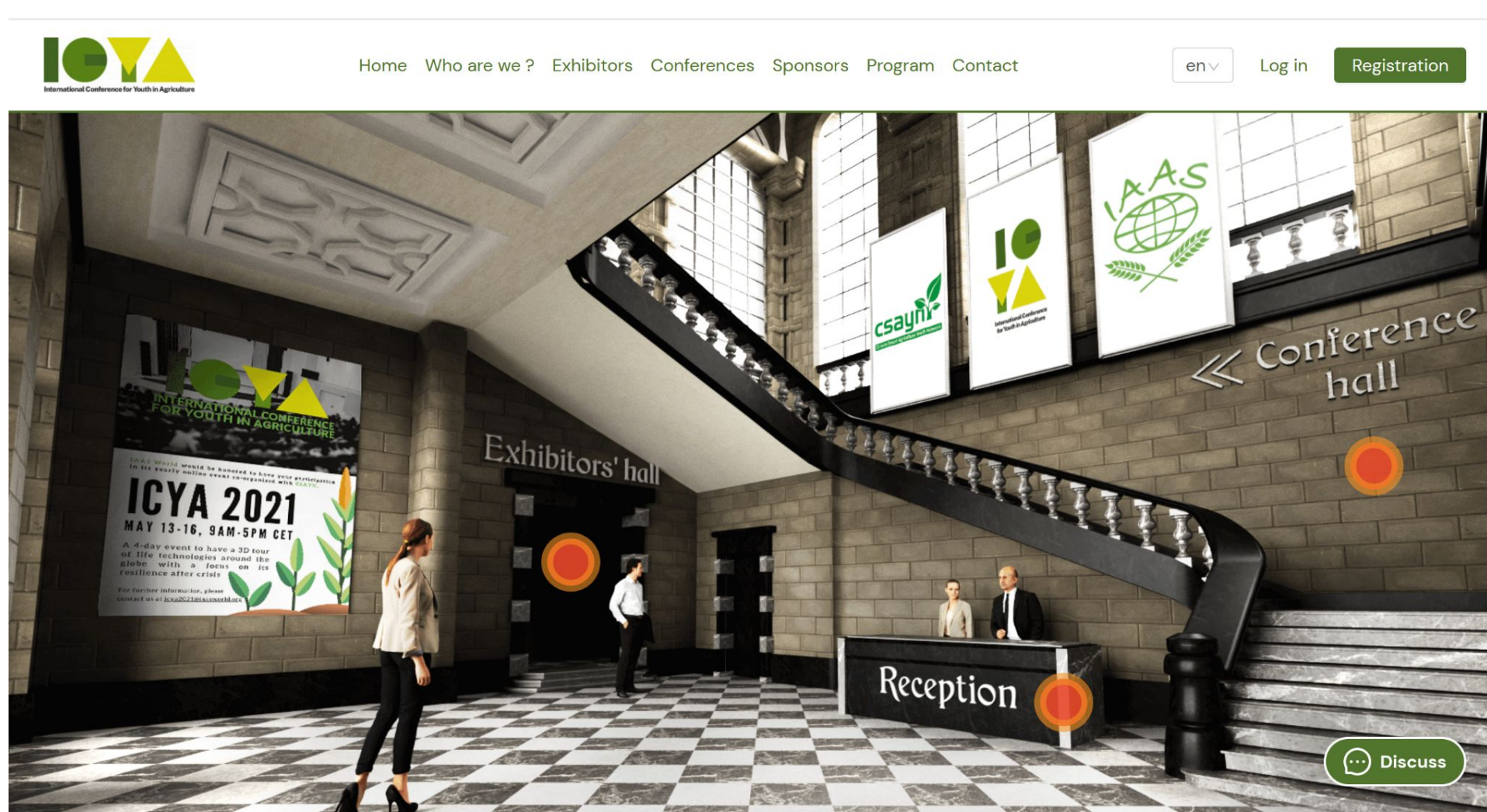

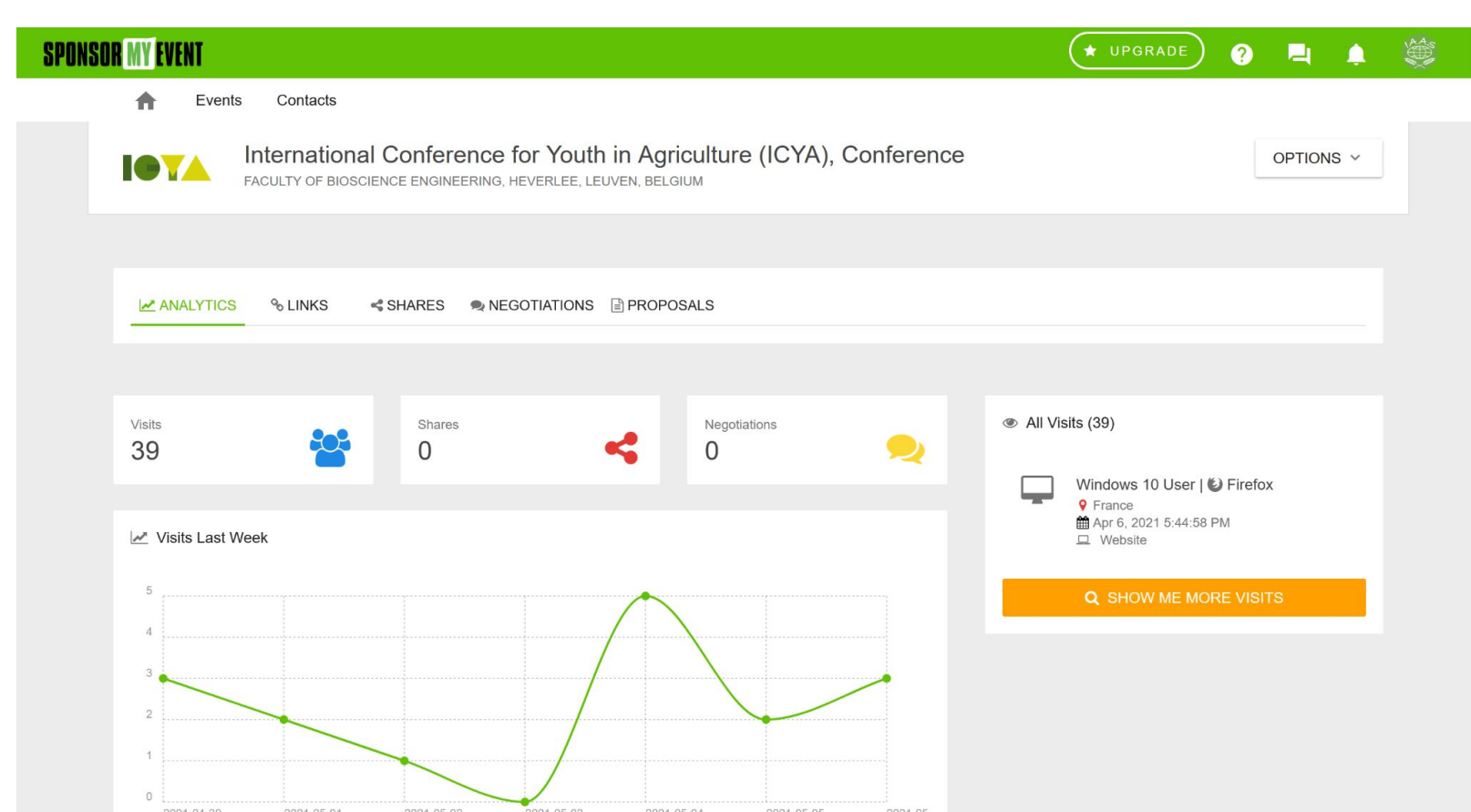

I spent the past months working on the organisation of the ICYA:

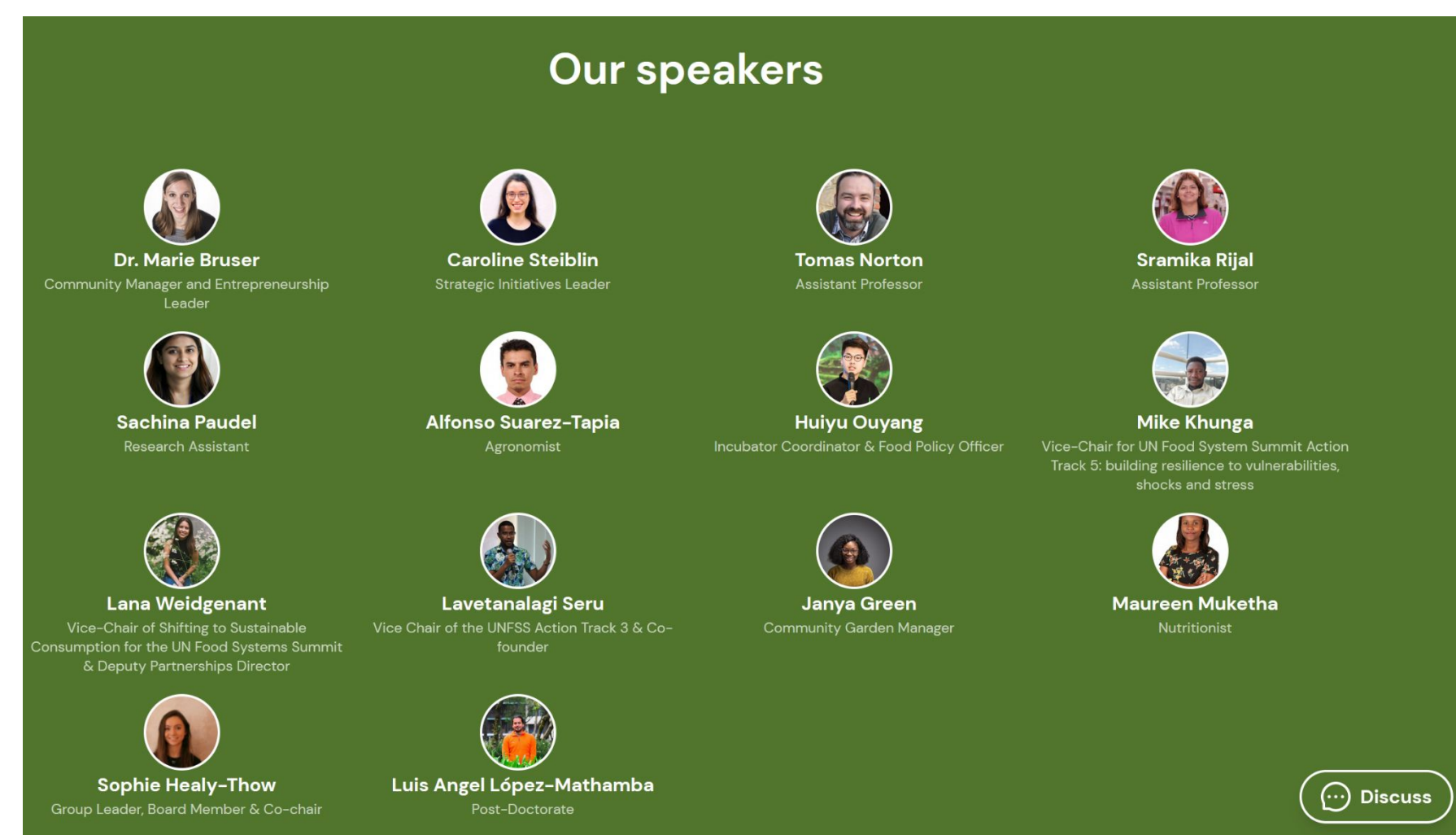
- Looking for sponsors (I created a sponsormyevent page and contacted around twenty different companies): Syngenta is therefore our loyal ICYA sponsor!
