I cannot wait to gather with all of you at the upcoming World Congress and to celebrate everything we've built in our final EBCB Courier this August.


Until then, please keep your fire burning bright. Keep showing the world what it means to be part of this incredible family. And above all, never stop believing in the power we hold, together.



CANDIDATE MEMBERSHIP


A Candidate Member country should have the intention to apply for full membership. A country can only apply a full membership needs to be handed in for voting at the General Assembly for the first time. A Candidate Member gains the status of Candidate Member. As a Candidate Member, the following rights are given:

- Being added to the IAAS mailing lists.
