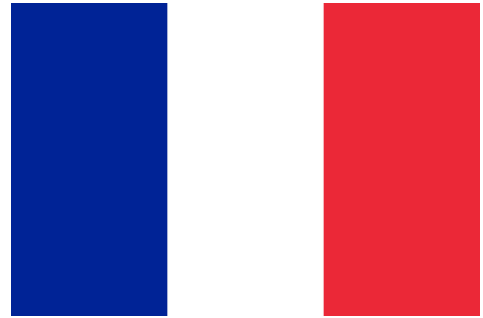

# IAAS FRANCE



## 1. International Exchange Pre-Event Survey

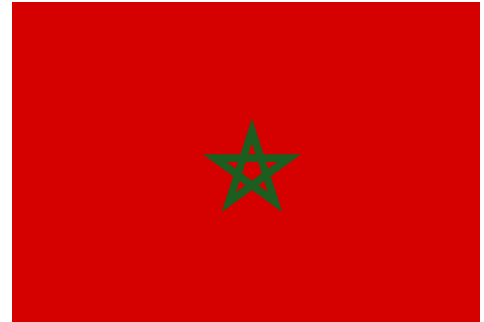
## 2. University of Zagreb Fair

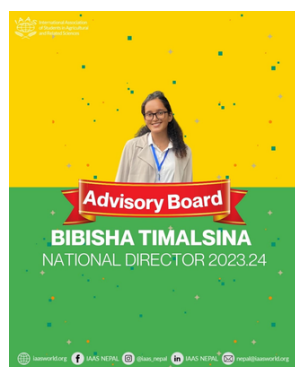



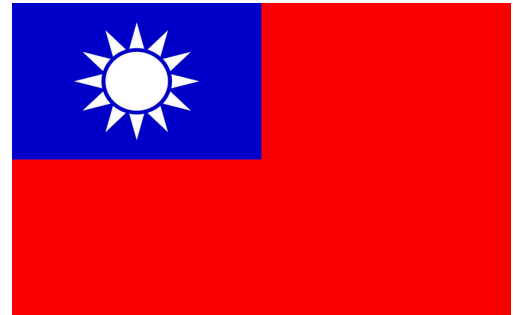
# IAAS TAIWAN

## 1. Academic Journey Sharing Session

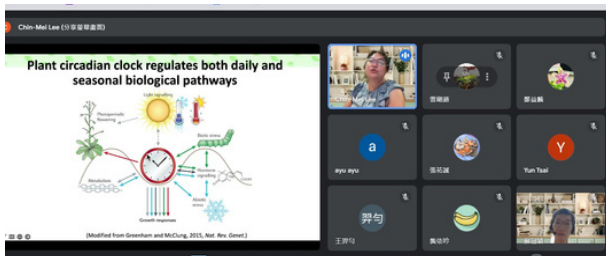
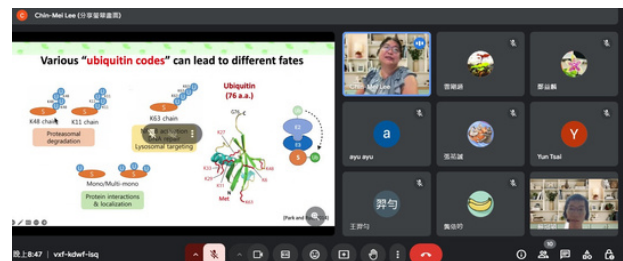
On November 19, 2024

We had our first meeting with this institution that has a lot of opportunities



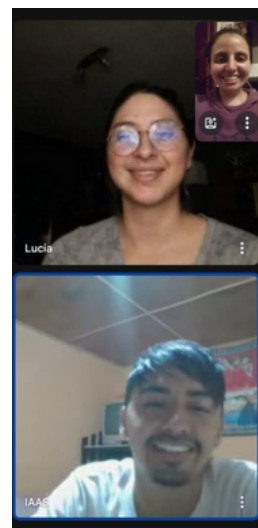
